

# HANCOCK PLACE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

*Please note this is just a general guideline, individual teachers may require additional supplies.*

**All grade levels will need a book bag and tennis shoes for gym.**

Please do not put names on supplies (except 5<sup>th</sup>). Supplies for 2010/2011 school year.

## 1<sup>ST</sup> GRADE

3 2-pocket folders (1 each: red, yellow, blue, solid colors only)  
1 box of 24 crayons  
3 spiral notebooks (wide ruled – 1 each: red, yellow, blue)  
1 pair of scissors  
15 Elmer's glue sticks  
1 box fat Crayola markers  
2 boxes thin Crayola markers  
2 boxes of Kleenex  
2 rolls of paper towels  
1 box quart Ziploc baggies  
1 box gallon Ziploc baggies  
**Boys** – 1 pkg. Baby Wipes and  
1 bottle hand sanitizer  
**Girls** – 1 pkg. Clorox wipes and  
1 bottle hand soap

## 2<sup>ND</sup> GRADE

2 2-pocket folders – 3 pronged  
1 box #2 pencils  
1 box of 24 crayons  
1 pkg. thin markers  
1 pkg. fat markers  
4 spiral notebooks (**wide ruled**)  
1 pencil **BAG (NO BOXES)**  
1 pair of scissors  
4 glue sticks  
1 pack of 4 **Expo** dry erase markers  
1 box of Kleenex  
2 additional boxes Kleenex in Jan.  
2 rolls of paper towels  
**Boys** – 1 box sandwich Ziploc bags  
**Girls** – 1 bottle hand sanitizer

## 3<sup>RD</sup> GRADE

6 pocket folders (diff. Colors)  
3 packages #2 pencils  
1 package black pens (girls)  
1 package red pens (boys)  
1 box of crayons  
1 package of markers  
5 spiral notebooks (wide ruled)  
1 eraser  
1 pair of scissors  
2 glue sticks  
3 packages of dry erase markers  
3 boxes of Kleenex  
1 roll paper towels  
2 packages of wide ruled paper  
1 box Ziploc bags (girls only)  
2 packages post-it notes (boys only)  
1 bottle hand sanitizer

## 4<sup>TH</sup> GRADE

3 pkgs. #2 pencils (12 count)  
1 box of crayons  
2 glue sticks  
1 pair scissors (blunt tip)  
1 pkg. pencil erasers  
6 spiral notebooks (wide ruled)  
Hand held pencil sharpener  
2 pkgs. Wide ruled loose-leaf paper  
10 pocket folders with prongs  
2 boxes of Kleenex  
1 roll of paper towels  
1 bottle of hand sanitizer  
1 pkg. of dry erase markers  
1 pkg. markers  
1 pkg. Post-it notes (girls only)  
1 sanitizing wipes  
1 box Ziploc bags (boys only)

## 5<sup>TH</sup> GRADE

2 each blue, black & pens (no gel pens)  
1 bottle of glue (no sticks)  
1 pair scissors  
1 box of crayons or markers  
1 pkg. colored pencils  
3 spiral notebooks (single subject)  
Pencil BOX  
2 pkgs. #2 pencils  
Erasers  
1 package wide ruled loose-leaf paper  
2 boxes of Kleenex  
1 roll paper towels  
Pencil sharpener with cover  
1 pkg. of 8 divider sheets  
1" binder (No zipper binders, please)  
1 or 2 dry erase markers  
Optional:  
1 box of crayons or markers  
1 pkg. colored pencils

***Please do not purchase a calculator for your child. Calculators needed for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> grades are not available in stores. They will be available for purchase (at cost) at the beginning of school.***
