RESPONSIBILITIES:* The Teacher will meet and instruct assigned classes in the locations and at the times designated.

* The Teacher will plan and prepare for the assigned classes and show written evidence of preparation upon request of the building Principal.

- * The Teacher will cooperate and work together with other staff members in planning, developing, writing, maintaining, and updating of curriculum and instructional goals, objectives, methods, and assessments.
- * The Teacher will plan, develop, and maintain a program of study that meets the individual needs, interests, and abilities of the students.
- * The Teacher will strive to implement by instruction and action the district's philosophy of education and instructional goals and objectives.
- * The Teacher will guide the learning process enabling students to progress in harmony with the curriculum goals, and establish and communicate clear objectives for all lessons, units, and projects.
- * The Teacher will create a classroom environment that exhibits positive, mutual teacher/student relationships conducive to learning and appropriate to the maturity and interests of the students.
- * The Teacher will maintain a physically and aesthetically attractive classroom setting and will exercise proper care and handling of district equipment.
- * The Teacher will assess the accomplishments of the students on a regular basis and provide progress reports as required and communicate with parents as deemed necessary.



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- * The Teacher will establish and maintain appropriate and cooperative working relationships with administrators, staff members, students, parents, and patrons.
- * The Teacher will recognize students encountering medical, physical, and/or psychological problems and will refer these students to the district's specialists as required.
- * The Teacher will assist the administration in implementing all policies and/or rules governing student life, behavior, and conduct.
- * The Teacher will maintain accurate, complete, and correct records as required by law, district policies, and administrative guidelines.
- * The Teacher will strive to maintain and improve their professional growth through an ongoing program of reading, workshops, seminars, conferences, and/or advanced coursework at institutions of higher learning.
- * The Teacher will attend and participate in all staff meetings and serve on staff committees as required.
- * The Teacher will participate in and share the responsibility for co-curricular and extracurricular activities.
- * The Teacher will make provisions for being available to students and parents for education-related purposes outside the instructional day when required or requested to do so, under reasonable terms.
